

COVID Leagues 2020 Rules and Playing Procedures

General

PLEASE ABIDE BY ANY APPLICABLE SOCIAL DISTANCING RULES AND WASH/SANITISE YOUR HANDS AS OFTEN AS REQUIRED

All matches to start at **6.00pm**

Scoring will be 2 points for a win 1 point for a draw and 0 points for a loss.

Results to be notified to Tim Bloomer by emailing results@fairfordbowlingclub.co.uk by the following **Saturday for the pairs** and the following **Monday for the triples**.

Both teams to send notification detailing the date, the match and the final score.

The winners of each league will be decided on the amount of points scored. If the points are equal the shot difference shall decide and if still equal the number of shots scored.

Play format

Pairs

Matches to play over **18-ends** with each player using **3 bowls**.

Teams are made up of 4 players, seeded on perceived ability and experience. The draw and fixture sheet shows who is playing when and where.

If a player is unable to play on an arranged date a substitute is from your own team is allowed. Where possible please try to use a substitute of equal or less ability than the one being replaced. At all times remember this league is for fun. If you are unable to field a team please re-arrange for the fixture to be played over the weekend as soon as possible.

Triples

Matches to play over **18-ends** with each player using **2 bowls**.

Teams are made up of 5 players, seeded on perceived ability and experience. The draw and fixture sheet shows who is playing when and where.

If a player is unable to play on an arranged date a substitute is from your own team is allowed. Where possible please try to use a substitute of equal or less ability than the one being replaced. At all times remember this league is for fun.

Jack and Mat Placement

To maintain hygiene standards the following will apply:

Please use 2 jacks (one at each end).

The lead of the team winning the previous end will place the mat as required **(please sanitise your hands often)**.

The skip of the team winning the previous end will place the jack where they wish on the centre line (within the normal rules of bowls regarding distance).

Disinfectant materials will be available at the ends of each rink.
